Challenger players and division commissioner Tony Fowler will arrive at 8:05 p.m. by fire truck courtesy of the Camp Hill Fire Department, to be welcomed by the community and the 2015 U.S. Little League Baseball World Series champions, Red Land Little League.

Activities include open swim and music. Light refreshments and door prizes will be available, including a 2016 Little League Baseball World Series Camp Hill Challenger jersey (a value of \$45) and a free night's hotel stay in Williamsport. All regular pool rules will apply; children must be accompanied by an adult.

Offering the program for more than 20 years, Camp Hill Little League Challenger Baseball has grown to six teams consisting of more than 70 players, each of whom has a physical or intellectual challenge.

The team is heading to the Little League Baseball® World Series on August 25th in advance of the Challenger exhibition game on August 27th, when it will square off against the Challenger team from Grand Junction, CO.
